



MEDICATION ASSISTED TREATMENT FOR OPIOID USE DISORDER

Medication Assisted Treatment (MAT) is the use of FDA-approved medications such as naltrexone (Vivitrol®), buprenorphine/naloxone (Suboxone®) or methadone along with comprehensive counseling and behavioral therapies - to help to provide a “whole-person” approach to address issues related to opioid dependence, including withdrawal, cravings and relapse prevention.

MAT Benefits:

- Provides safe, psychiatric provider-controlled medication that blocks, reduces or alters the effects of opioids
- Consistent counseling and focus on healthy thinking patterns, lifestyle changes, coping skills and improving family and friend relationships

MAT Goals:

- Reduce symptoms and signs of withdrawal
- Reduce or eliminate craving for opioids
- Block effects of opioids
- Restore normal physiology
- Promote psycho-social rehabilitation and a drug-free lifestyle

MAT Outcomes:

- Reduction in drug-related overdose deaths
- Improved treatment outcomes
